Primary Goals:

- Provide high-quality, cutting-edge seminar speakers to primary undergraduate institutions in our region with limited resources to host seminar speakers. Faculty wishing to host a seminar speaker may sign up here.
- Provide speaker experience for post-doctoral fellows preparing to enter the job market.

How to Apply:

- Identify up to two primary undergraduate institutions in the region (Southern Nevada or Arizona) at which to give a seminar. Contact them to indicate interest in presenting a seminar. Mention this program in your contact letter.
- Before travel, provide the Branch Treasurer, Dr. Helen Wing, details of the arranged speaking event (dates, time, host institute, and hosting PI) and email confirmation of the seminar from the host using the Google form entitled "Post-doc Development Support for Travel".
- To be reimbursed, applicants must receive a confirmation email from Dr. Wing confirming availability of funds for sponsored travel.
- After email approval and travel, submit receipts for reimbursement to Dr. Helen Wing using asm"at"unlv"dot"edu.
- The branch will cover gas, accommodation (up to 3 nights total for 2 seminars), and per diem up to the U.S. General Services Administration (GSA) rates.

Eligibility: Open to postdoc members of the Arizona and Southern Nevada branch of the ASM, with at least 1.5 years of post-doc training and one first-author publication from their post-doc position. Limit of 1 application per person. Awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Start Date: July 1st, 2025

End date: Until funds are exhausted (estimated \$1000)
